

Product: 5 Loop-black
Style: Updo



1. Brush all of the hair to the crown and take the center of the Loopy Twister and put it into your hair as a tight, high ponytail, temporarily ignoring the other five loops. Then, pull and straighten the loops, so they are evenly distributed around the ponytail. Fan your hair over the top of the bands and divide into five sections.
2. Take the first section of hair on the top left and pull it through the first loop, tightening the band around the hair until it is secure and leaving a mini-ponytail. Take the second section of hair from the top right side and pull it through the second loop tightening the band around the hair. Take the third section of hair from the bottom right and pull it through the third loop and once again, tightening the band around the hair. Next, take the bottom band and secure the pony by tightening the band. Finish the last strand of hair by securing it. Now you have five mini ponytails.
3. Begin at the top left again, and work around the head, pulling the elastic out and pulling her hair through until a mini loop forms (see video if necessary) from four of the five mini ponytails, leaving the bottom ponytail straight down for this particular style.
4. Start by picking and pulling at the very center, a little bit at a time, until a small bun starts to appear. Keep gently pulling from the middle, then the sides until you get the desired look. Back and forth, spreading the hair, pulling it down and out, until the look is soft and pretty...perfect for prom or special occasions and no bobby pins needed!

Remember, you can always print out these directions and watch the how to video again, and then make notes for yourself. This style is more advanced so it takes watching the video a couple of times to understand.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
