

Product: 4 Loop-black
Style: Dressy



1. Brush hair into a ponytail and take the center of the Loopy Twister and put it into your hair, as if it were a regular ponytail holder, temporarily ignoring the other four loops.
2. Divide the hair that is through the ponytail into four equal parts. Loop each one of the five segments through the smaller loops. Loop each one twice, so that you now have four mini ponytails.
3. Now take each mini ponytail and tighten the band around it, creating a loop. Depending on the thickness of the hair, you may be able to achieve this by tightening a third time, or by pulling the hair back through the band creating four loops that are all the same size and very securely held by the looped band.
4. Now for the magic trick, pull the center of middle section, as if you were tightening a ponytail. You should see a bun appearing in the middle of the four loops. If you do not, you may need to gently pull up on the center of the hair to encourage the bun.
5. Now, gently go back and forth pulling and tightening the loops and the center bun until you get the desired look.
6. For a little wilder of a style, pull a strand of hair all of the way out from the top loop of the hair and fan over the rest of the loops. If you decide you don't like that, then just loop it up again.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until freed, and then repeat with the other four strands of hair. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
