

Product: 4 Loop-black
Style: Modern updo



1. Take the crown section of hair from both sides, as well as the bang section and brush back into a partial ponytail in the top of the crown of your head, hair spray your bangs back if necessary. Take the center of the Loopy Twister and put it into your hair ignoring the rest of the hair and the other four loops. Then, pull and straighten the loops, so they are across the head evenly. Push or clip the hair in the ponytail forward, to get it out of your way.
2. Take the first section of hair, straight across the bottom middle section, just below the twister pulling it through the middle loop, tightening the band around the hair several times until it is secure, leaving a pony.
3. Split the bottom hair into two sections, take the right section and pull it tight, crossing over and securing it to the opposite loop on the left. Then, take the remaining hair on the left bottom, again pull straight up and into the loop on the right, creating a zig-zag. Keep it pretty tight.
4. Pull the hair (backwards) back through the loop to create a bun. Repeat, pull the hair back out of the next loop, and the next loop, leaving some hair straight down as well, creating little bows and buns in your hair. Gently pull and straighten to get the desired look...the motion is up and back. Please see video again if you need to!

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
