

Product: 5 Loop-black
Style: Pony with braid



1. Take all of the loops and bring them to the top of the band. Brush 40% of the hair into a ponytail at the lower, middle part of the head, taking the center of the Loopy Twister and put it into your hair as a tight ponytail, temporarily ignoring the other five loops. Then, pull and straighten the loops, so they are evenly distributed at the top of the ponytail.
2. Take the first, middle section of hair on the top between the crown and the bangs and pull it through the middle loop, tightening the band. Take the next section of hair in the top right area and braid a strand before crossing it over and pulling it through the next loop to the left and tightening the band around it (crossing over the middle from right to left and securing) Although this may sound confusing, basically you are just making a ponytail, using all 5 loops and criss-crossing the hair before putting it in the bands...remember, you can always watch the video again!
3. Take the section of hair that is in between the ear and the bangs on the left side, crossing it over to the right side and tightening the band around the hair. Now you have about equal parts left over in the front bang area on either side. Take the remaining hair on the right and bring it back and pull it to the same side looping the band around the hair to secure it.
4. Take the last section of hair on the left and if you have enough hair, divide this strand taking the first section and bringing into the last loop on the left securing it. Take the last section of hair, braid it and then pull it into any loop you want to complete the look. Tighten the ponytail and smooth out any fly aways.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
