

Product: 3 Loop-black
Style: Casual Using 2 loops



1. Make sure the three loops have one loop at the top and one on opposite sides of each other. Take three quarters of your hair in the back, at your crown and put the center twister in it, temporarily ignoring the three loops. Then straighten the loops, so there is one at the bottom and the other two on either side. The loop at the bottom will not be used so tuck it away. You will have the front bang section of your hair outside of the loops for now.
2. Take the hair that is left and divide it into two sections. Then divide each section in two and twist one section and then twist the other section on the same side joining the two, and bring them acrossed and into the first loop that is on the opposite side, securing it until it is tight.
3. Take the second section of hair that is left over on the right side and divide it in two, twisting one section and then twisting the other section, joining the two sections of hair and then bring it acrossed and place it in the second loop on the opposite side and pull it through, securing it by looping the band around it. Pull on the bands to tighten and make sure the hidden loop is still not visible.
4. We found twisting, curly hair before putting it into the mini loops helps cut down on tangling. Remember to check the video again if you need help.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
