

Product: 3 Loop-black
Style: Wrap pony



1. Make sure the three loops have one loop at the top and one on opposite sides of each other. Take less than half of your hair in the back, just below your crown and put the center twister in it, temporarily ignoring the three loops. Then straighten the loops, so there is one at the top and the other two below, on either side.
2. Take the hair that is from the middle section (bang section) of your hair and bring it directly back and into the first loop, securing it until it is tight. For a variation, you can tease this hair, or twist it, before bringing it back and securing it.
3. Take the hair that is left over on the right side and bring it around and place it in the second loop on the opposite side and pull it through, securing it by looping the band around it. Take the hair that is out on the left side and pull it tight in order to wrap around the bands and give it a couple of twists before wrapping the hair around the bands. Put it into the third loop, pulling it through, securing the band. Pull on the bands to tighten and tuck or hide any bands that are showing underneath.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
