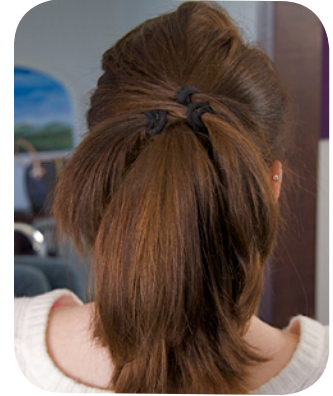


Product: 4 Loop-black
Style: Ponytail



1. Brush about 1/3 of the hair at the crown and take the center of the Loopy Twister and put it into your hair as a tight, high ponytail, temporarily ignoring the rest of the hair and the other four loops. Then, pull and straighten the loops, so they are evenly distributed around the ponytail.
2. Take the first section of hair on the top right and cross it over the center of the twister, twisting the ends a bit in order to pull it through the opposite side's loop (top left loop) tightening the band around the hair until it is secure and leaving a mini-ponytail. Take the second section of hair from the left side, near the ear (leaving a front section of hair down) and pull it acrossed and over to the right bottom loop tightening the band around the hair.
3. Take the third section of hair from the left side (the bang hair) and pull it through the third loop located at the top right and tighten the band around the hair, making sure it looks good from the front. Lastly, take the bottom band and pull the hair straight up, smoothing any bumps out and secure the pony by tightening the band. You can always temporarily clip up the top pony so you can see better before working on the last loop. Now you have four mini ponytails. Tighten up and smooth any fly away hairs and you are finished.

To Remove:

Pull each small strand of hair straight out until hair is freed. Then pull middle out like you would a regular ponytail and straighten out Loopy Twister for next use.
